Scholarship Rules

Scholarships will be awarded for any college or trade school.

Eligibility requirements are as follows for qualifying Corvette Cleveland members:

- a. Children
- b. Grandchildren

A qualifying club member is a club member who has been a member for at least 2 years. Member will also need to be an NCCC member in good standing.

A Scholarship will not be awarded for graduate study beyond a Bachelor's degree.

Previous scholarship winners will be eligible to receive the award again in subsequent years.

Application Requirements:

1. All sections of the attached scholarship application must be filled out completely.
2. Post mark date or deadline for submission of all documents to the board will be March 1st of the scholarship year.
3. Applicant should provide a copy of their official high school transcript along with an acceptance letter from an accredited trade school or college.
4. For an existing college student, a copy of the official college transcript will be a requirement.

5. Applicant will provide 3 Letters of recommendation. Letters can only be written by Teachers, Employers, Guidance Counselors and Clergy. No letters from relatives will be accepted. The letters must provide the address and phone number of the person writing the letter. They must also state their occupation and how they know the applicant.
6. A typewritten essay needs to be submitted by applicant explaining why they feel they should be considered for this award. The essay should be at least a 300 word minimum to a 500 maximum and clearly state applicants' career goals.
7. Applicant will need a GPA of 3.0 or better
8. Applicant will provide a record of involvement in extracurricular activities for high school or college.
9. The applicants will be notified by April 15th of the scholarship year.
10. The scholarship will be presented at the first club meeting in the park in May of the scholarship year. Applicant(s) will need to be present to accept, with reasonable acceptations.
