SHOW HISTORY

In 2003, after having a Corsa exhaust installed on their 1994, the idea of Corvette Cleveland holding a show at Corsa came to Elaine Obert. She suggested it to Corsa with the intention of raising money for charity.

The first show was chaired by Elaine and Christy Miller. The club shared National Council of Corvette Club sanctions with Buckeye Corvettes, but that was the only year we shared hosting the show. The goal at the first show was to have 50 Corvettes attend, but there were 85! The unique Corsa tip trophies make winning very desirable.

By 2006 we had 228 Corvettes attending! In 2007 Elaine was chairman along with Bob Kirsch. In 2008 Jim Drabik, Dave Derrig and Angelo Costanzo were chairmen. In 2009 Jim Drabik and Dave Derrig were Chairmen and continue to serve as current chairmen for this year.

In 2008, Wendell Strode from the Corvette Museum attended. In 2012, the 10th Anniversary of the show, we had an outstanding attendance of 252 Corvettes entered!

In 2013, the highlight of the show was having Kirk Bennion (Corvette Exterior Design manager) and his wife Debbie attend the show, bringing with them a 2014 C7 Stingray Corvette for everyone to see and sit in. What a surprise for the crowd and a real crowd pleaser. Many pictures were taken. We were pleased Kirk and Debbie also attended the after party at the Oberts, and we have an awesome group picture. The 2013 show had a whopping 271 Corvettes entered.

Corvette Cleveland had donated thousands of dollars to local charities as a result of this event.

Charities supported have been Fairview Hospital Pediatrics ward, which received a Corvette pedal car, and Berea Children's Home now called Ohio Guidestone. The club had gift basket raffles, 50/50, auctions, Goodyear tire raffle, and Corsa exhaust raffle to help raise money. Total amount donated to Corsa show charities is \$51,475.
